

# Johnny's Sweet Alyssum



Attracts beneficial insects. Sweet Alyssum is fast and low growing, trouble free, and low cost, making it a popular choice for use as a beneficial insect habitat in vegetable and fruit production. Attracts beneficial insects such as lacewings, parasitic wasps, syrphid flies, and tachinid flies. Well-branched plants with dense clusters of small flowers. Commonly known as sweet alyssum, but also known simply as alyssum. Perennial in zones 9-11.

Prefers sun/part shade in average, well drained-soil. Plant 6-8" apart. Excellent beneficial plant. Good for edgings, borders, beds, rock gardens, window boxes, and hanging baskets.
