

Johnny's Black Krim Organic Tomatoes



Russian heirloom tomatoes. Black Krim combines bold, smoky flavor and good texture with an unusual appearance. Deep brown/red, 8-16 oz. tomatoes have brown/green shoulders that get darker with more heat and sunlight. Indeterminate; should be staked, trellised, or caged, and pruned for best results. Fruit ripens over an extended period.

Transplant into medium-rich garden or field soil 14-20" for staking. Water seedlings with a high-phosphate fertilizer solution. For earliest crops, set plants out around the last frost date under floating row covers which will protect from frost to about 28°F (-2°C). If possible, avoid setting out unprotected plants until night temperatures are over 45°F (7°C). Frost will cause severe damage!
