## Johnny's Flashback Mix Organic Calendula



AKA pot marigolds. Spectacular mix of colors with bi-color petals. The undersides of the petals are a muted burgundy giving the flowers a unique, flashy appearance. An excellent mix of colors; high percentage of double and semidouble flowers on long, strong stems. Also known as pot marigold, common marigold, and Scotch marigold. Prefers sun/part shade in rich, well-drained soil. Space plants 6-12" apart.

Fresh flowers: Harvest when flowers are ½ open.

Edible Flowers: Petals of the flowers can be used fresh or dried in "flower confetti," soups, soufflés, rice dishes, baked goods, and to garnish desserts.

Calendula is a popular choice for brightening up salad mix. Flavor is tangy and slightly bitter. Remove the petals from the flower base before consuming as the base can be quite bitter.
