

# Johnny's Great White Organic Tomatoes



The 12+ oz. fruit is meaty with few seeds, a mild non-acid flavor, and creamy texture. The medium-tall plants are less viny and mature earlier than other "whites". Indeterminate; should be staked, trellised, or caged, and pruned for best results. Fruit ripens over an extended period.

Transplant into medium-rich garden or field soil 14-20" for staking. Water seedlings with a high-phosphate fertilizer solution. For earliest crops, set plants out around the last frost date under floating row covers which will protect from frost to about 28°F (-2°C). If possible, avoid setting out unprotected plants until night temperatures are over 45°F (7°C). Frost will cause severe damage!
