

Fedco Greek Oregano



Strong oregano aroma and flavor; great for pizza and Italian cooking. Characteristic dark green leaves with white flowers. Does best in well-drained, sandy soil. Space plants 12" apart in sun/part shade. If grown in rich soils it may lose its pungent scent. When the danger of frost has passed in the spring, transplant outside, spacing plants 12" apart in rows 18" apart. To keep plants looking attractive, pinch back new growth, remove any old wood at the end of the winter, and replace the plants every 4 years.

Edible Flowers: The flowers have an oregano flavor and can be used in the same manner as the herb. They are especially good in pasta salads, green salads, and as a fresh pizza topping.
