

High Mowing Lacinato Dinosaur Organic Kale



Organic, non-GMO heirloom kale. Unique blue-green savoyed leaves on extremely vigorous plants. One of our most tender kale varieties; ideal for raw kale salads and soups. Leaves are very dark blue-green and heavily savoyed, sweetening with each frost. Also known as Dinosaur or Tuscan kale. Our strain has been improved by breeder Frank Morton of Wild Garden Seeds and is exceptionally large, vigorous and cold-tolerant.

Improved vigor, yield and hardiness. 30-40" tall.

Kale prefers a fertile, well-drained soil high in organic matter with a pH range of 6.0–7.5. Consistent moisture will produce the best quality leaves.

Begin harvesting about 2 months after planting by clipping individual leaves. Kale is very hardy, and the eating quality will improve into the late fall with light frost. Late summer sown or planted collards can be wintered in cold frames or hoopouses, or in the open in mild regions, to extend the season. Protecting with row covers can extend the harvest period.
