

Johnny's New Girl F1 Organic Tomatoes



First early, great flavor! Fruits avg. 4-6 oz. and have better flavor and are more disease resistant than Early Girl. Holds better than First Lady II. Widely adapted. High resistance to fusarium wilt races 1, 2 and verticillium wilt. Indeterminate; should be staked, trellised, or caged, and pruned for best results. Fruit ripens over an extended period.

Transplant into medium-rich garden or field soil 14-20" for staking. Water seedlings with a high-phosphate fertilizer solution. For earliest crops, set plants out around the last frost date under floating row covers which will protect from frost to about 28°F (-2°C). If possible, avoid setting out unprotected plants until night temperatures are over 45°F (7°C). Frost will cause severe damage!
