

# Johnny's Triloba Rudbeckia



Densely-branched, daisy-like flowers. Profuse blooms of small, 1 1/2" – 2 1/2", bright yellow flowers with small, black/brown centers. Wiry, well-branched stems have few leaves making this an excellent cut flower. Tolerates most conditions, including drought, once established. Short-lived perennial; typically flowers first year but may not bloom until second year if heavily crowded. Also known as brown-eyed Susan and brown-eyed Susan.

Prefers sun/part shade in average soil; drought tolerant once established.  
Space plants 18-24" apart. Excellent cut flower.

Seeds pre-chilled for 30 days for higher quality results.
