White Wonder Organic Tomatoes



One of the varieties chosen for Alice Waters' famous Chez Panisse restaurant. Medium-sized fruits ripen creamy white color and have a sweet flavor. Productive plants, good foliage cover. Fruits are medium-sized. Indeterminate; should be staked, trellised, or caged, and pruned for best results. Fruit ripens over an extended period.

Transplant into medium-rich garden or field soil 14-20" for staking. Water seedlings with a high-phosphate fertilizer solution. For earliest crops, set plants out around the last frost date under floating row covers which will protect from frost to about 28°F (-2°C). If possible, avoid setting out unprotected plants until night temperatures are over 45°F (7°C). Frost will cause severe damage!
